

Good afternoon, Team!

Great news! We are changing how smoke alarm monitors are programmed into SimplyHome systems so that moving forward, selling/using a key fob to deactivate the alarm is no longer required. This will do three things client-facing:

1. Save money! (they don't have to buy the key fob and subsequently, and inevitably, replacement key fobs)
2. No hassle with deactivating the butler announcement caused by activation of a smoke alarm monitor - the butler will no longer announce anything if the smoke alarm monitor picks up the siren sound of the smoke detector it is mounted next to. It will just do whatever alerts were requested as part of the programming (ex: text, email, etc.). This will likely eliminate people yanking/cutting cords out of the butler to get it to stop announcing when they panic and cannot find the key fob.
3. This means no need to train staff/families/individuals on using the key fob and trying to keep it in a safe place where it won't get lost (because it won't exist!).
